# Choral Rehearsal Technique & Working with Accompanists

Join us for a day of conducting and singing as Dr. **Eric Nelson**, Director of Choral Studies at Emory University and Artistic Director of the Atlanta Master Chorale, leads our first workshop of the season. Topics will focus on choral conducting and rehearsal technique, as well as the "art" of working with an accompanist. Participants will have the opportunity to actively engage as both singers and directors with the guidance of Dr. Nelson and accompanist **Jonathan Easter**. A boxed lunch will be served at 12 noon. While the workshop is free, the cost for lunch will be \$10, and a reservation is requested.

As a bonus following the workshop, St. James' Guild of Change Ringers will present a tour and demonstration of the church's eight tower bells.


